County Water Line Shutdown & Repair will impact some residents on Wednesday, 10 March

Recently, we learned that the county Department of Water Supply has scheduled a repair of main water lines along some of our Paauiilo Mauka and Kalopa roads.

Our new “Water, Health & Utilities” chair, Liam Gray, has contacted the water department and confirmed that the work will take place on **Wednesday, March 10, from 8:30am to 12:30pm**. The official letter and map (which have not been widely circulated to affected residents) are given below.

The roads that will be affected within our community are:

- **Kalopa Mauka Rd**
- **Kalaniai Road**
- **Waika’alulu Rd (the lower portion only)**

If you live on one of these roads, please read on for more details and precautions. Also, consider passing the word on to your neighbors who may not get this notice.

The letter states that the shutdown is required to replace two water main valves. The letter continues to inform residents that:

- Upon resumption of service, the waterlines will be flushed and cleaned, during which time the water may appear turbid or discolored.
- There may be trapped air in your plumbing which will be released as you initially use water.

The letter also advises that “affected customers are asked to take any and all precautions necessary to protect customers’ property and facilities including, but not limited to, disabling electrical power to pumps and/or any other devices whose normal operation may

WATER SHUT-OFF NOTICE

AFFECTED AREA: ALL SERVICES ALONG KAHANA DRIVE, KALEHUA ROAD, KALŌPĀ MAUKA ROAD, KALANIAI ROAD AND LOWER PORTION OF WAIKA’ALULU ROAD; HĀMĀKUA, HAWAII

Water will be temporarily turned off in the above-mentioned area on **Wednesday, March 10, 2021, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.** to replace two (2) water main valves.

Upon resumption of water service, the waterlines will be flushed and cleaned during which time you may notice turbid and/or discolored water.

You may also notice trapped air in your plumbing, which will be released as you initially use water.

Affected customers are asked to take any and all precautions necessary to protect customers’ property and facilities including, but not limited to, disabling electrical power to pumps and/or any other devices whose normal operation may be dependent on water pressure and/or water supply, and which might be damaged if automatically energized during the water shut-off.

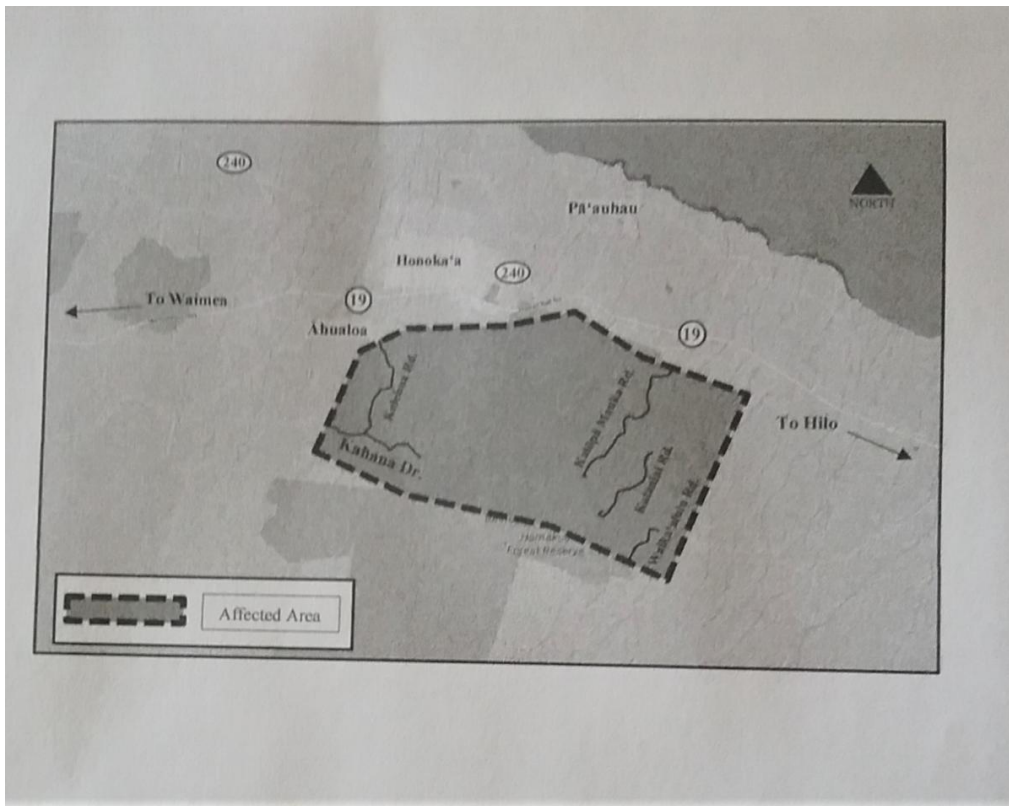
